

COOKIES POLICY

The following Cookies Policy sets out the rules for registering and accessing data on Users' Devices using the Website ("the Service") for the purpose of providing electronic services by the Website Administrator.

§ 1 DEFINITIONS

Service - a website running at <https://geekslings.com/>

External service - internet service owned by partners, service providers or service recipients of the Administrator

Administrator - **Geek Slings Marta Gąsior**, operating at the following address: **Katowicka 59a/3, 61-131 Poznań, Poland**, with a tax identification number (**NIP**): **7282870038**, providing services electronically via the Website and storing and accessing information on User devices

User - a physical person for whom the Administrator provides services electronically via the Website

Device - an electronic device with software through which the User gains access to the Website

Cookies - text data collected in the form of files placed on the User's Device

§ 2 TYPES OF COOKIES

Internal cookies - files uploaded and read from the User's Device by the ICT system of the Service

External cookies - files placed and read from the User's Device by the ICT systems of External Services

Session cookies - files uploaded and read from the User's Device by the Service or External Services during a singular session. After the session ends, files are deleted from the User's Device.

Persistent cookies - files uploaded and read from the User's Device by the Service or External Services until they are manually removed. Files are not deleted automatically after the end of the Device session unless the User's Device configuration is set to the Cookie delete mode after ending the Device session.

§ 3 SECURITY

Storage and reading mechanisms – cookie storage and reading mechanisms do not allow for downloading any personal data or any confidential information from the User's Device. There is very little possibility of transferring a virus, Trojan horses or other worms to the User's Device.

Internal cookies - internal cookies used by the Administrator are safe for Users' Devices

External cookies - Administrator is not responsible for the safety of cookie files from partners of the Service. The list of partners is provided further in the Cookies Policy.

§ 4 OBJECTIVES TO WHICH COOKIE FILES ARE USED

To improve and facilitate access to the Website – the Administrator may store in cookie files information about the User's Website preferences and settings in order to improve and facilitate the supply of services.

Statistical data - the Administrator and External Services use cookies to gather and process statistical data, such as i.e. statistics of visits, User Devices or User behaviour. These data are collected in order to analyse and improve the Service.

Social networking services - the Administrator and external websites use cookies to support social networking services.

§ 5 EXTERNAL SERVICES

The Administrator cooperates with the following external websites, which may place cookie files on User's Devices:

Google Analytics and **Facebook**

§ 6 POSSIBILITIES OF DETERMINING THE CONDITIONS FOR STORAGE AND ACCESSING THE USER'S DEVICE THROUGH THE SERVICE AND EXTERNAL SERVICES

The User may, at any time, independently change the settings for saving, deleting and accessing stored cookie files. Information on how to disable cookies in the most popular browsers and mobile devices is available at: [how to disable cookies](#). The User may, at any time, delete any cookie files saved to date on a Device used to access the Service.

§ 7 SERVICE REQUIREMENTS

Restricting the recording and access to cookie files on the User's Device may cause the Website to work improperly. The Administrator shall not bear any responsibility for such Website malfunctions if the User limits in any way the option of saving and reading cookies.

§ 8 CHANGES IN COOKIE POLICY

The Administrator reserves the right to change this Cookies Policy at any time without informing users.

The introduced changes enter into force on the date of publication of the Cookies Policy.
